PESTICIDE USE WITHIN ¼ MILE OF SCHOOLS

Starting January 1, 2018, California Code of Regulations 6690, 6691 and 6692 restrict the agricultural use of pesticides within ¼ mile (1320 feet) of all public schools and licensed day care facilities and requires a yearly notification to both the school and this office. These restrictions are enforced Monday through Friday, 6:00am through 6:00pm, unless otherwise noted on your permit.

Notification requirements

Prior to April 30th, property operators must notify all schools and day care facilities of potential pesticides that maybe applied during the school year. A map showing the site and school, grower contact information and a link to the National Pesticide Information Center website must also be on your notification.

If you acquire new property within ¼ mile of a schoolsite, you must notify the school 48 hours prior to spraying.

CalAgPermits has a new module to assist in the notification process, you must have a current account with CalAgPermits to access this module.

Application Restrictions

All aerial, airblast, fumigation and sprinkler chemigation applications are prohibited Monday through Friday, 6:00am through 6:00pm within ¼ mile of schoolsites.

Ground applications, including strip spraying, hand held pressurized hose and broadcast applications, are prohibited within 25 feet of all schoolsites Monday through Friday, 6:00am through 6:00pm.

There are no restrictions for backpack sprayers, bait stations, or hand pump sprayers.
