PROJECT LOCATION: Five (5) parcels on the north side of State Route 20, approximately 340 feet east of Lytle Road and west of N Colusa Frontage Road; APN: 13-280-148, 13-280-158, 13-280-159, 13-280-160, 13-280-161

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A General Plan Amendment for five (5) parcels totaling 19.39± acres from Agriculture-80 (AG-80) / Ranchette (RAN) to Industrial/Commercial (I/C) and a Rezone for the same five (5) parcels from Agriculture (AG) / Ranchette (RAN) to Commercial Industrial (CM).

FINDINGS/DETERMINATION: An Initial Study of the effect of this project has been made, and it has been determined that there will be no significant adverse effects on the quality of the environment with mitigation incorporated; therefore, a Mitigated Negative Declaration is proposed.

PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD: A 30-day public review period for the Mitigated Negative Declaration will commence on May 9, 2025 and end at 5:00 pm on June 9, 2025, for interested and concerned individuals and public agencies to submit written comments on the document. Any written comments on the Mitigated Negative Declaration must be received within the public review period.
