## Simple Steps to Protect You and First Responders



Sign up for emergency alerts to stay informed.

CodeRED is Sutter County and Yuba County's official **emergency alert system**. Choose how you want to be contacted - mobile, landline, text, or email.

Help first responders find your property quickly in an emergency.

Install at least 1 smoke and carbon monoxide detector on each floor. Test monthly.

The Red Cross will install **free smoke detectors** for anyone in need. Bed shakers and strobe alarms available.
